

CARGO & MOORING BUOY FORM 2025

Items to go direct from RSYC to RLYC Langkawi

- The truck will be available for loading Thursday and Friday before the first race day.
- This form must be completed, fee paid and all items placed on the lorry at RSYC by the Friday before first race by 20:00.
- Cargo lorry will NOT be going to Pangkor.... It will travel direct to Penang, Straits Quay to arrive Monday evening and will be available ONLY between 10:00 to 20:00 on Tuesday and Wednesday for anyone to access ONLY their personal effects suitcase to do a clothes swap. If any bag is taken off the lorry it MUST be returned before 20:00 on Wednesday, otherwise it will not be taken on the next leg to Langkawi, as the lorry has to leave VERY early Thursday to reach the ferry on time. Anything not reloaded at Penang will not be collected .. it will be your responsibility to recover.
- ➤ Because the secure truck is kept at RSYC for the few days before leaving Saturday monring it is recommended that any items that cannot withstand normal in-car tropical heat levels (35°+C) are not loaded.
- > Items MUST be secured and marked with the boat name or carry an endorsed waterproof ticket / label.
- Items will be delivered to Royal Langkawi Yacht Club on Thursday (Race 5) evening but is dependent upon ferry sailing delays. All items and must be collected before 18:00 on the last day of the regatta.
- > Items can be retrieved ONLY upon presentation of this receipt form.
- NO FUEL can be carried for obvious safety reasons empty can must be washed out and fume free before loading.
- ➤ Neither the regatta organisers, nor RSYC accept any responsibility for delayed delivery, loss, damage or consequential loss for any items or effects carried herein, nor mooring buoy usage. Insurance for these items is the sole responsibility for the owner.

MOORING BUOYS

- Anyone renting a laid mooring buoy outside Straits Quay does so upon the complete understanding that the regatta organisers have laid such moorings to the best of their ability and it is the sole responsibility of the boat PIC to be satisfied that the mooring is sufficient to hold their boat overnight.
- All boats are encouraged to leave at least one crew on board overnight to keep watch.
- Note that mooring buoy fee is now part of the online entry form and can also be pre booked there
